
Each is precluded from any engagement within this instant case because no judge may preside over any case that challenges the legality of *his/her own* prior personal actions and/or inactions.

As a former officer for any court of the Texas state court system, **all judges listed above** are clearly disqualified from this constitutional challenge case against the very same daily unlawful practices and patterns exhibited by each and every such instant Texas district court, and therefore he/she has direct conflicts of interest within this case as to inherently prejudicial rulings either for and/or against *untold numbers of unconstitutional actions committed within and by each such judge*, and moreover, he/she is further precluded because no prior officer or agent of the State of Texas, i.e., anyone who ever worked for and/or got paid by the State of Texas, may preside over a case involving the State of Texas *as one of the parties* within these very most serious matters.
